## How to access the school library

Home: return to main screen
Search: search for specific books, using: word, subject, author, series etc


Pick \& Click: Search using pictures to select subject areas.


New: search new books that have come into the library.
Ebooks: free ebooks that can be downloaded to read.
My library: current loans and loan history


Leave orbit: will take students to another style of searching

6. When you have found a book of interest. Click on the link or book cover.

7. This will give more information on the book including a blurb


It will also tell you if the book in available, on loan or missing.
8. If you would like to reserve this book click on the


RESERVE
Your reservation has been placed

The message will appear:
Students may reserve a book that is currently on loan, however they will need to wait patiently until it has been returned to the library. When it becomes available students will be notified that it available for borrow.

## Cancelling a reservation

1. If you wish to cancel a reservation click the home button and go to My Library.
2. Click on the Reserves tab

3. Click the $X$ beside the book you wish to cancel the reservation for can confirm that cancelation.

## Prep and year 1

1 book from either junior fiction or junior non-fiction

## Year 2

Up to 2 books from junior fiction, junior non-fiction and quick fiction

## Year 3

Up to 3 books from junior fiction, junior non-fiction, quick fiction, fiction and nonfiction (either 2 fiction and 1 non-fiction or 2 non-fiction and 1 fiction)

Year 4-6
Up to 4 books from junior fiction, junior non-fiction, quick fiction, fiction, senior fiction, senior picture books and non-fiction. (maximum of 2 fiction or 2 non-fiction at any one time)
