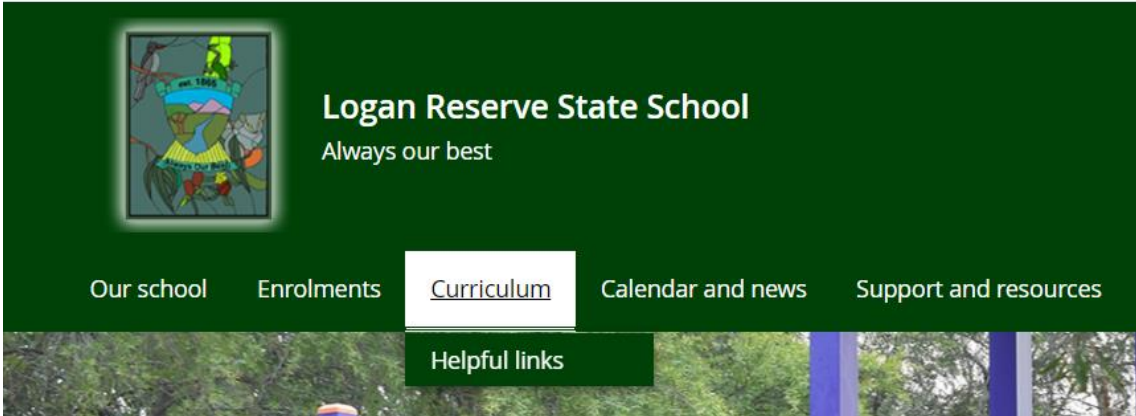


How to access the school library

Students are able to browse the catalogue for books in the school library. They are also able to make a reservation for books. Students will be notified by email when their book is ready to collect.

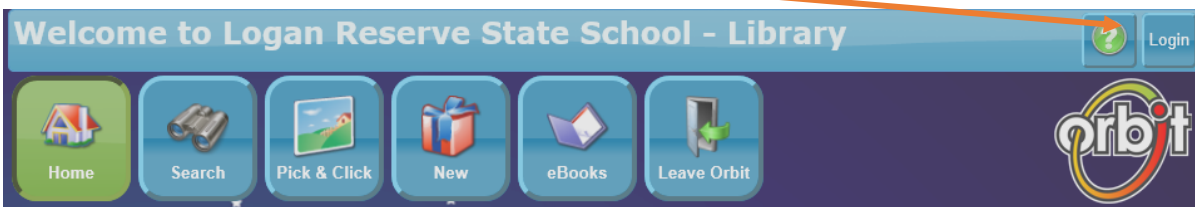
1. Click on Curriculum and then Helpful links



2. Click on the orbit link



3. Click on Login in upper right corner



4. Use the user name and password on your/your child's password lists

Pick & Click: Search using pictures to select subject areas.



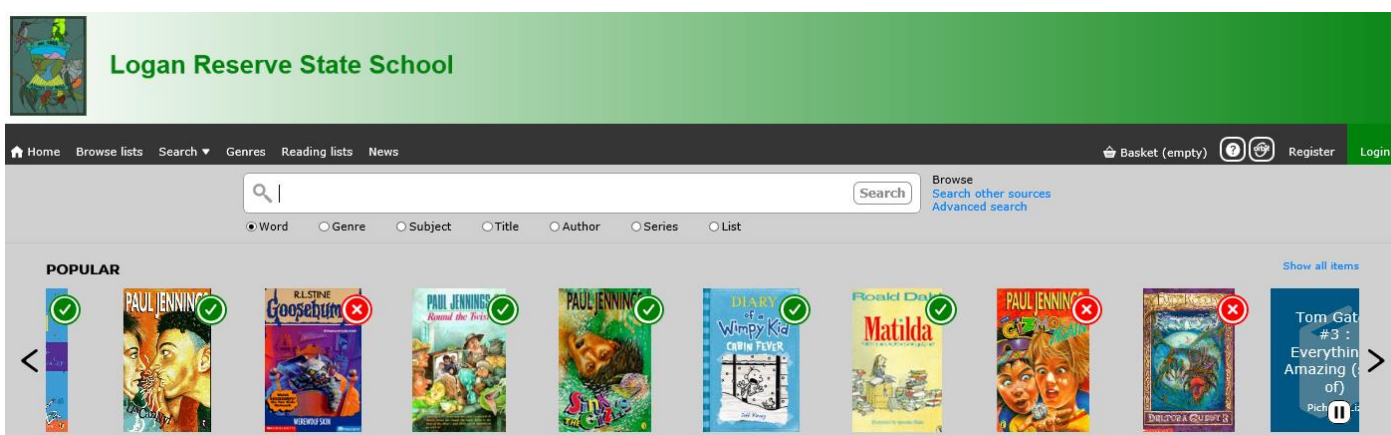
New: search new books that have come into the library.

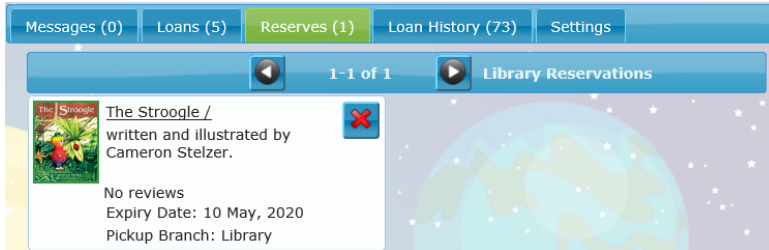
Students may reserve a book that is currently on loan, however they will need to wait patiently until it has been returned to the library. When it becomes available students will be notified that it is available for borrow.

Canceling a reservation

1. If you wish to cancel a reservation click the home button and go to My Library.



2. Click on the Reserves tab



3. Click the X beside the book you wish to cancel the reservation for can confirm that cancelation.



Frequently asked questions

What sections can I/my child borrow from?

Prep and year 1

1 book from either junior fiction or junior non-fiction

Year 2

Up to 2 books from junior fiction, junior non-fiction and quick fiction

Year 3

Up to 3 books from junior fiction, junior non-fiction, quick fiction, fiction and non-fiction (either 2 fiction and 1 non-fiction or 2 non-fiction and 1 fiction)

Year 4 – 6

Up to 4 books from junior fiction, junior non-fiction, quick fiction, fiction, senior fiction, senior picture books and non-fiction. (maximum of 2 fiction or 2 non-fiction at any one time)
